

## Incentive itinerary Auckland 3 days - 2 nights

### Day 1

Guests will be met on arrival at Auckland airport and will then be escorted to their 5 star accommodation to relax for a couple of hours. They will then be collected from their hotel and shown the main sights of Auckland, the “City of Sails”, including some of the famous volcanoes such as Mount Eden, One Tree Hill and Mount Victoria. In addition they will be treated to one of the most beautiful city drives in the world, Tamaki Drive from Auckland city via Mission Bay, Kohimarama Beach and St. Heliers Beach to Achilles Point with stunning view over the Hauraki Gulf. They will see Rangitoto Island, Motukorea (Browns Island), and as far as Great Barrier Island and the Coromandel Peninsula on a clear day. Next the Scenic Drive across the Harbour Bridge to the marine suburb of Devonport. This evening’s dinner will be on Auckland’s Waitemata Harbour on an exclusive Dinner Cruise with fine cuisine and wine to match. It will take in the sights of Auckland from the water, while showcasing some of the most spectacular of Auckland from the water.



### Day 2

After breakfast delegates will be treated to a unique and interactive Maori culture experience they won't forget. They will be collected by a luxury vehicle to match the group size and will be shown the many sights on the way to their exclusive experience (not open to the public!) on an authentic community Marae – a real Maori Meeting House that is normally not used for tourism. They will meet real and everyday Maori and New Zealanders and they will have the opportunity to interact with them, ask questions and become part of the community for a full day. After a Powhiri (traditional welcoming ceremony), the delegates will have the unique opportunity to:

- Interact with the locals in a relaxed and informal manner;
- Learn about local Tikanga (Maori customs & Traditions);
- Preparing a hangi (earth oven) meal. Please note that we will not just serve them a hangi but will give them the opportunity to be taken through the entire process incl. food preparation – a unique opportunity;
- Basic Te Reo Maori (Maori language);
- Learn the Haka, war dance made famous by the All Blacks rugby team. This includes the meaning behind it in addition to performing the Haka. Please note this is not a show but highly interactive, a once in a lifetime opportunity to go way beyond normal visitor activities;
- Flax Weaving (Harakeke);
- Wood Carving (Whakairo). One of Aotearoa/New Zealand's top master carvers and some of his family is frequently part of this exceptional day. He has produced many significant carvings, including some in

New Zealand's Parliamentary Buildings, for the Maori King and others. He is also a great storyteller and can answer all relevant questions posed by the delegates.

They will sleep after a highly eventful, interactive and magnificent day in a 5 star luxury accommodation.



### Day3

Starting the day in a magical way, delegates will have breakfast at their accommodation, before travelling on for a unique adventure that is only available in New Zealand: Kite Fishing with TIME Unlimited Tours & Travel, who will drive with them to a stunning beach location in Auckland / southern Northland depending on the wind conditions for a day of nature, beach, relaxation, great food and wine on the beach, plus the opportunity to learn and participate in this fascinating (and highly successful!) method of using the wind and kites to catch dinner. This self-caught dinner will then be expertly prepared for them with a matching bottle of fine New Zealand wine to round off a perfect day. Vegetarians and other food needs will be catered for. Watching the sunset (conditions permitting) will be followed by a return to Auckland city after a real "Kiwi-style" adventure.
